The Ambe Society Calgary is committed to supporting students who embody our values of service, dedication, and excellence. Our scholarships provide financial assistance to deserving individuals pursuing their academic journeys.

Eligibility Criteria: To be eligible for the Ambe Society Calgary Scholarship, applicants must:

Citizenship: Be a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident of Canada, or Protected Person under Canada's Immigration and Refugee Protection Act.

Residency: Be a resident of Calgary and surrounding area. Applicants must provide proof of Calgary (and surrounding area) residency for at least 12 consecutive months prior to applying.

Academic Standing: Be enrolled full-time in the second or subsequent year of an undergraduate or professional program at an eligible publicly funded post-secondary institution in Alberta.

Grade Point Average (GPA): Achieve a minimum GPA of 3.2 on a 4.0 scale based on an 80% full course load in the previous fall and winter terms.

Program Eligibility: Be enrolled in a program that is longer than one year in length.

Ineligibility Criteria: Applicants are not eligible for the Ambe Society Calgary Scholarship if they:

- Are enrolled in a one-year certificate program.
- Do not return to a publicly funded post-secondary institution in the fall or winter terms of the next academic year.

Application Process: Complete the scholarship application form available on the Ambe Society Calgary website.

Supporting Documents:

- References

Submission: Submit the completed application form along with all supporting documents to the Ambe Society Calgary.
